




# ILLUSTRATOR GUIDE

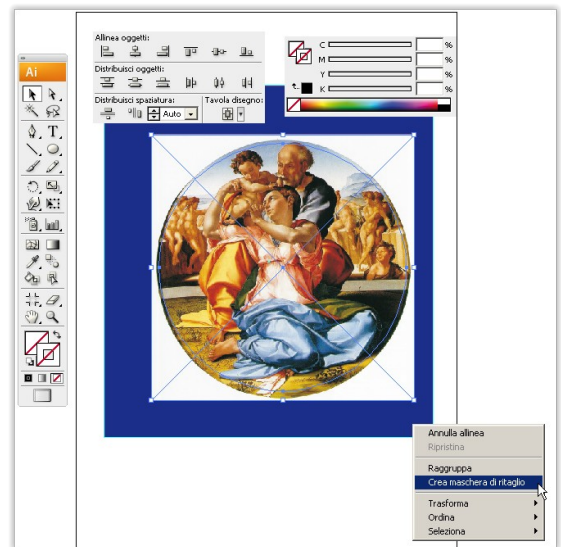
## 1- Guide to print without white ipg or tiff without trasparenza

<p>1 In Illustrator, create a new blank document and import the image</p>	
<p>2 Check if the image has the white outside that WE DO NOT WANT print. To do this, we create a colored rectangle that we place BEHIND the image.</p>	
<p>3 To avoid printing white, we will place the image IN to a path. Begin with the create the path (in this case a simple ellipse). The color of the track and the coverage will be "no one".</p>	

4 Align the track perfectly with the image, as desired



5 Select both objects (track and image), and click the right mouse button. Give the command "create clipping mask"



6 The result will be that. Before printing, remember to delete the blue rectangle or move it to a level not printable.
